2. How is the word "world" used differently in the following verses? Acts 17:24, John 13:1, John 12:31, Romans 3:19, John 15:18
3. How is the word "world" used in our passage?
4. In what sense are we to love the world as God loved it (John 3:16) and in what sense are we to hate it (1 John 2:15-17)?
5. What is worldliness? How can we escape it?
6. According to 1 Timothy 4:1-4, what kind of people are more prohibitive than God? Why is it that adding rules beyond the Scripture is harmful?
7. What is to be the Christian's posture toward the world? How are we to interact with it in a way that shows we know who made it and that it is good, but that the system of worldliness is bad?
